General terms & conditions of Smeets Agro Consultancy

Smeets Agro Consultancy has its registered office in Horn, The Netherlands, and its principal place of business in Schelkensven 40, 6085 DG Horn, The Netherlands.

Smeets Agro Consultancy gives advice and renders services daily to companies, government and organizations in any possible way. This operational, techno-economical, strategic and organizational consultancy, information and guidance to companies in the agricultural and horticultural sector, small and medium-sized businesses, organizations, government and other companies is given both by telephone and in writ ing, and also during company visits

As Smeets Agro Consultancy attaches much importance to good advice and guidance, Smeets Agro Consultancy thinks it is also important to have clear "rules of the game". Both for Smeets Agro Consultancy and for you. These rules of game are indicated hereafter in the General Terms and Conditions of Smeets Agro Consultancy as registered with the Chamber of Commerce Roermond, The Netherlands.

1. General

- These terms and conditions apply to all offers and quotes and all agreements concluded with Smeets Agro Consultancy with respect to services, like for example advice, information, research and sale of movable property by Smeets Agro Consultancy. These conditions also
- apply to all (legal) actions preceding or in implementation of quotes, offers and / or agreements. These conditions also apply to all agreements with Smeets Agro Consultancy, for which execution Smeets Agro Consultancy makes use of third-party services.
- Stipulations deviating from these terms and conditions are only valid if these have explicitly been agreed upon in writing by all parties.

- All offers and/or quotes are without engagement, unless it has been stipulated explicitly that they are irrevocable, and unless expressly otherwise stipulated they are valid for a period of fourteen days, counted from the date of the offer and/or quote.
- Agreements can only be concluded by written acceptance by Smeets Agro Consultancy of an order, or by execution of the order by Smeets Agro Consultancy.
 The scope of the activities covered by an agreement is
- determined by the offer, including the changes that are inserted later on by mutual agreement.

- The prices given by Smeets Agro Consultancy are exclusive of the value added tax (VAT) and other government
- The prices published by Smeets Agro Consultancy in catalogues or in any other form, are not binding for Smeets Agro Consultancy. After concluding the agreement, Smeets Agro Consultancy is entitled to raise the agreed prices in case of, among other things, interim price increases and/or surcharges on freight, customs tariffs, prices of goods and/or raw materials, taxes, wages or social security charges, depreciation of the Dutch currency and/or appreciation of foreign currency, and any other government measures that make prices
- In case of an increase of net prices, the customer is entitled to cancel the agreement, provided that he shall give notice in writing to Smeets Agro Consultancy within four-teen days after having been informed about the increase of net prices. In case of cancellation of the agreement. the customer has no right to compensation

4. Execution of the agreement

- The agreement shall be executed within the (estimated) period that has been determined in consultation with the customer and that is mentioned in the offer, unless this turns out not to be reasonably feasible. If the deadline threatens to be exceeded, Smeets Agro Consultancy shall discuss this as soon as possible with the customer
- However, Smeets Agro Consultancy shall never be in default de jure by just exceeding the deadline. By concluding a contract agreement Smeets Agro Consultancy only binds itself to carry out the ordered activities, seeking to achieve a useful result for the customer.
- With respect to the application of crop protection and fer-tilization advice, Smeets Agro Consultancy bases its advice on the applicable statutory provisions (statutory use instructions, fertilizer regulations, etc.). The user instructions (doses, application techniques, etc.), given both orally and in writing, are based on extensive tests. Smeets Agro Consultancy advises its customers to the best of its ability and applies today's relevant know how which also implies that Smeets Agro Consultancy cannot vouch for the unknown harmful consequences of the advised use of crop protectors or fertilizers arisen at the time that advice was given.

 In the event of Smeets Agro Consultancy selling mova-
- ble property, Smeets Agro Consultancy will not provide any guarantee other than described in the offer, without prejudice to any guarantee given by the producer that can solely be claimed against the manufacturer. Smeets Agro Consultancy will solely carry out additional work following approval of the customer, after which the costs of
- additional work may be charged to the customer. With respect to confidential information of the customer provided to Smeets Agro Consultancy in the framework of execution of the agreement, Smeets Agro Consultancy shall observe secrecy, in that sense that Smeets Agro Consultancy shall never publish these data in a

- way that they can be directly traced to the customer. A way that they can be directly faced to the customer. A further obligation to observe secrecy shall expressly apply if this has been explicitly agreed upon in writing. Research results shall be disclosed anonymously, unless upon written request of the customer secrecy has
- been agreed, the period of secrecy not exceeding one year counted from delivery date/invoice date.
- Any obligation for Smeets Agro Consultancy to observe secrecy, does not apply to the extent that Smeets Agro Consultancy would then act contrary to its legal tasks

5. Obligations and responsibility of the customer

- In case of inspection of samples, the customer is responsible for the selection and representativeness of the samples and he is also responsible for timely delivery of the samples to Smeets Agro Consultancy.
- In case of advice by Smeets Agro Consultancy with respect to the use of crop protectors or fertilization, the actual application or use and storage are not controlled by Smeets Agro Consultancy. This implies that the responsibility for correct execution of the given advice fully rests
- The customer accepts that there is a real possibility of misinterpretation of the questions or advice in case of telephone advice, and that the risk of misinterpretation of the question or misinterpretation of the advice will be at

6. Delivery, risk and ownership

- Movables will be delivered from the business location of the Smeets Agro Consultancy branch with which a contract is concluded and at the moment of delivery the risk of these goods passes on to the customer.
 In case of delivery of movables, Smeets Agro Consul-
- tancy remains the owner of all goods delivered to the customer until the purchase price of all goods has been paid in full.
- Copyright and all other intellectual or industrial property rights of given advice and information remain exclusively ested in Smeets Agro Consultancy.

7. Payment

- Payment shall be made within fourteen days of the date of invoice. Smeets Agro Consultancy will send an itemized invoice to the customer.
- Invoices for once-only and/or occasional deliveries will be paid by direct debit, for which the customer gives a direct debit authorization to Smeets Agro Consultancy by filling out and signing the corresponding part of the order
- If the customer does not agree with direct debit of the invoice amount, handling expenses and costs of collection re payable in addition to the invoice amount.
- If no fixed price has been specified in the order confirma-tion or agreement, then it has common ground for the parties that the amount payable will be determined by Smeets Agro Consultancy on basis of subsequent calculation according to Smeets Agro Consultancy's usual rates and methods.
- Smeets Agro Consultancy is entitled to send invoices at regular intervals. Smeets Agro Consultancy may at all times require payments in advance, even if this is not included in the order confirmation or agreement.
- In case of overdue payment, the statutory interest is pay able from due date and so are all costs incurred with spect to the collection, without notice of default being re-
- In case of payment, the other party does not have re-
- course to compensation, deduction or deferment. In the event of the customer cancelling an appointment for a company visit and suchlike, which had been agreed between Smeets Agro Consultancy and the customer, and in the event that this cancellation is made less than 24 hours in advance of the time of appointment, the cus tomer shall pay 50% of the hourly rate. The customer will receive an invoice for this.

- Smeets Agro Consultancy is only liable for the damage that are directly caused by a failure in the execution of its obligations imputable to Smeets Agro Consultancy. If Smeets Agro Consultancy is liable for direct damage to the customer in virtue of the contractual liability referred to in the previous sentence and/or in virtue of any other matter, it is liable to a maximum amount of € 11,500.-- or to at most the amount that the customer is obliged to pay in virtue of the agreement if this amount is higher. This direct damage also includes the damage that the customer sustains due to application or use of the result of the activities of Smeets Agro Consultancy; however it does not include any lost profits of the customer as a consequence of the activities of Smeets Agro Consul-
- Smeets Agro Consultancy is not liable for damages of any kind, if the information provided by or on behalf of the client was incorrect or incomplete. Under no circumstance the liability of Smeets Agro Con-
- sultancy shall exceed the amount that is paid in virtue of the business liability insurance taken out by Smeets Agro Consultancy
- The customer indemnifies Smeets Agro Consultancy and/or the persons employed for the execution of the agreement against all claims from third parties in virtue

of the damage sustained by these third parties due to the application or use of the activities of Smeets Agro Consultancy by the customer or another person whom the customer has provided with the results of the activities, unless in case of gross negligence and/or intention of Smeets Agro Consultancy and/or the persons called in by Smeets Agro Consultancy for the execution of the agreement.

9. Complaints

- The customer cannot appeal against the fact that the deliverable does not comply with the agreement if he/she has not given notice in writing to Smeets Agro Consultancy within the reasonable period after he/she has discovered or reasonably should have discovered that the
- deliverable is not in accordance with the agreement. Complaints with respect to invoices, externally visible defects of the deliverable and reasonably detectable inac-curacies in case of advice or deviations from the assignment, should be submitted with Smeets Agro Consultancy in writing within four weeks of the date of invoice, in default whereof any appeal against these shortcomings and/or inaccuracies becomes expires.

Smeets Agro Consultancy shall be entitled to dissolve the agreement and shall have the right to claim damages from the customer, if the customer fails imputably, if he/she applies for a moratorium on payments, if he/she is declared bankrupt, if the customer dies, or - in case of a legal person - if this legal person is dissolved, or if the company of the customer is liquidated.

11. Applicable law and competent court

Only Dutch law applies to the agreements concluded with Smeets Agro Consultancy. All disputes will in the first instance be settled by the competent court in Roermond (The Netherlands), unless Smeets Agro Consultancy gives preference to the court in the place where the customer has his registered office or domicile, or unless imperative law prescribes otherwise.
